

Group Placement: What group do you enroll in? If you have no experience playing your instrument then the Concert group is where you want to be. Experienced players will have an opportunity to play for us in order to determine placement. Students wishing to join Jazz Band will need to meet with Jacki for an audition and should be enrolled in Wind Ensemble or Chamber Orchestra. Contact Jacki for group placement. Note: Students who wish to play percussion must have 2 years of piano experience & meet with Jacki prior to enrollment.

Choosing an Instrument: For beginning students or someone who might want to start a different instrument we are offering a fun, week long, hands on Exploring Instruments Camp that will help you pick which instrument is the best fit for you! Look for dates in June and August; enroll online at www.REWMusic.net

Materials Needed: Each student will be responsible for providing their own Instrument, Method Book, Folding Music Stand, and any other necessary accessories. REW Music will provide any additional sheet music needed for class. (Rental instruments are available; see a store team member for details.)

GROUP POLICY

TUITION PAYMENT & SCHEDULE

- Tuition is paid at time of registration to ensure your spot.
- Tuition includes weekly group sessions 80 minutes in length.
- Tuition is not prorated for missed classes, late entry or early withdrawal.

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT

- The enrollment form, tuition and registration fee must be received by the enrollment deadline as stated on the enrollment form.
- One completed enrollment per student is necessary.

ATTENDANCE & MISSED CLASSES

- Quality is paramount at REW and our classes are no exception. In order to provide the highest quality education for
 each musician, we highly recommend and encourage each student attend all classes in which they are scheduled. In
 addition they should practice at home every day in order to be prepared for class.
- The instructor must be notified by phone if you are not able to make it to class.
- Students with inconsistent attendance **will not** be allowed to participate in concerts or performances.
- Students must arrive at least 10 minutes prior to class time, and be in their seats with tuned instruments at class time.
- If the instructor is unable to teach class, a substitute may be provided.
- In the rare event of inclement weather, the decision to cancel class on the day in question will be made by REW Music administration and we will then attempt to notify each student. If we cancel class due to weather we will make every effort to schedule a make-up time.

CODE OF CONDUCT

REW Music Homeschool Groups are Christian based groups. We will play a variety of music some of which may be religious.

- We expect students to act in a respectful and honorable manner.
- The director reserves the right to deny students participation in a rehearsal or performance due to inappropriate behavior.
- Foul language or unwholesome talk, roughhousing, disruptive behavior, physical display of affection (PDA), disrespect for authority and/or REW Music property, and all other inappropriate behavior as deemed by the director are all grounds for disciplinary action.
- REW Music reserves the right to remove a student from the program for disciplinary reasons. No refunds will be given.

DISCONTINUING ENROLLMENT

- If a student wishes to withdraw from class, written notification must be submitted to the director.
- Class tuition is non refundable.



REW Homeschool Approved Instrument Policy

REW Music is proud to offer an exceptional homeschool band and orchestra group experience. Since we began offering the program in 2011, we have found that we have more and more instruments that are presenting challenges to the students' musical experience. Some of the instruments, despite the student's best efforts, are not of the quality to allow the musician to excel. We spend a lot of time trying to make sub-quality instruments play in tune, or work at all.

We have found misinformation in the marketing of school instruments, and inconsistencies in their production. Instead of creating a list of acceptable brands, we will provide a free evaluation of all instruments for quality and repair status. All instruments will need to be evaluated by the REW Music Repair Shop prior to the enrollment deadline.

We are not trying to sell additional instruments or repair services. We want to make sure that the instruments in the program allow all of the musicians to be the best they can be and not be hindered by the issues that can be caused by sub-quality instruments, such as excessive repair time and difficult intonation. We have had instruments in the program that have hampered the progress of not only the individual student, but the entire group. We want to ensure that all of our students are provided a quality program.

If you are considering a new (or new to you) instrument purchase, please consult with REW Music before you buy. We will be happy to evaluate any instrument and let you know if it will meet our standards for the homeschool program.

Concert Sheet Music Return Policy and Service Fees

ALL concert sheet music must be returned in good condition, free of pencil markings, tears, and excessive wrinkles. Music must be returned before leaving the concert venue (or before the day of the concert if the student is unable to participate). We will provide an "Erasing Station" where students may erase and return their music. If concert music is returned late, damaged beyond repair or lost, non-refundable fees will apply.

Late Music:

Music not returned at the concert will incur a \$30.00 (+ tax) late fee. If some titles are returned by the deadline but not all, the same late fee still applies. Beginning the Tuesday following the concert, an additional \$2.00 (+ tax) per title will be added for each day that music remains outstanding until received. If music is not received within 7 days, it will be considered lost and replacement fees will also apply.

Lost or Damaged Music:

If music is lost or damaged beyond repair (at the discretion of REW Music) you will be invoiced a replacement fee at the current market price plus a \$30.00 service fee for each piece of music.
